FOODBANK UPDATE

- the Foodbank at St Matthew's. Redhill continues to be very busy, providing food for about 80 families a week. These donations are taken to Redhill on Fridays. The foodbank is closed between Christmas and New Year, except for urgent collections only on Wednesday 30th December.
