#### **FOODBANK UPDATE**

- the Foodbank at St Matthew's. Redhill continues to be very busy, providing food for about 80 families a week. Of course that covers households of varying sizes, so the number of people in need is well over that number. Donations can be left at The Rectory. There is a bin on the doorstep. These donations are taken to Redhill on Fridays.

There are two different initiatives for donations this Christmas:-.
